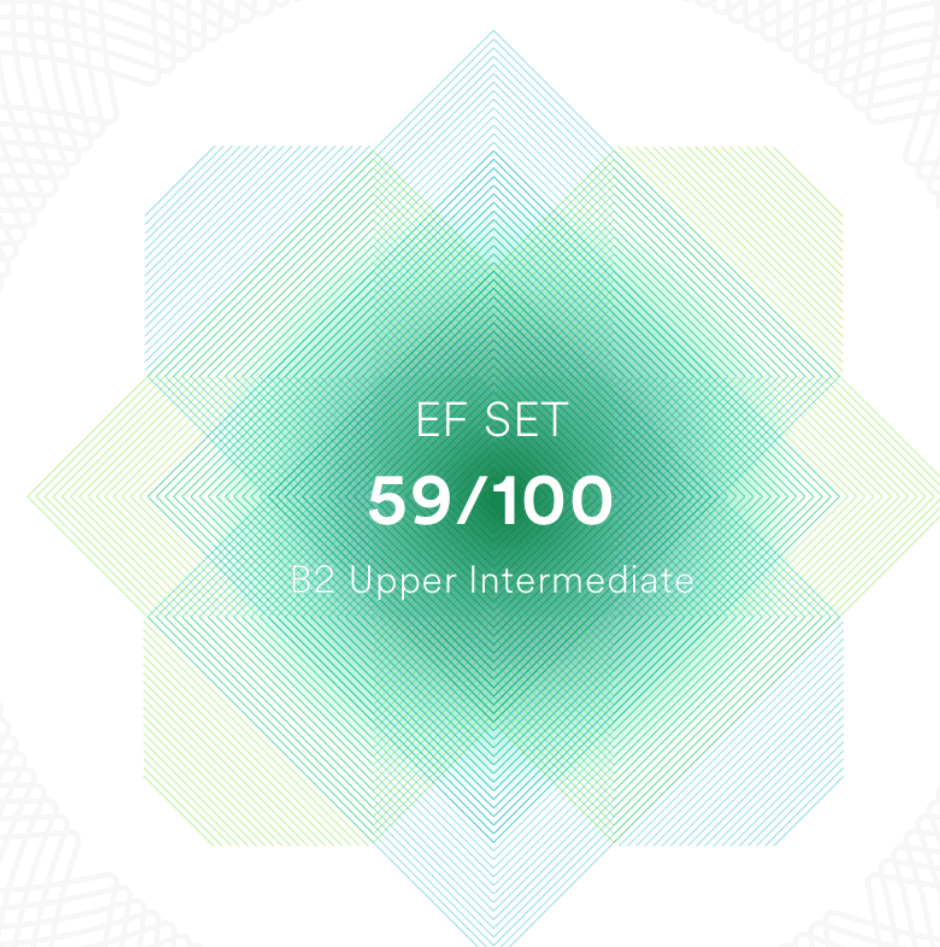

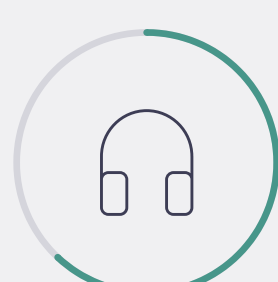

UNDERSTANDING THE RESULTS

The achieved English level is 59/100 on the EF SET score scale and B2 Upper Intermediate according to the Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR). The EF SET score is calculated as an average of the reading and listening scores.

Reading Section 56/100 B2 Upper Intermediate

At this level, it is easy to comprehend articles on many subjects and in most cases, arguments and disagreements can be followed. Also, a variety of specialized written texts can be understood.

- Can understand the main ideas of complex text on both concrete and abstract topics, including technical discussions in his/her field of specialization.
- Can read articles and reports concerned with contemporary problems in which the writers adopt particular attitudes or viewpoints.
- Can understand contemporary literary prose.
