In The Great Yonder European Solidarity Corps team-volunteering project, volunteers supported the preparation and the implementation of an international gathering in a tiny village in North-Hungary, which is being turned into a green, innovative cultural meeting point. Volunteers helped at the festival, creating a space that welcomed artists, intellectuals, musicians from all over Europe to be in a community where members are free to share and learn from each other, collaborate, explore and create together.
